## CHAIRMAN'S UPDATE

Firstly, I would like to thank all those members that responded with their views on which species to stock at Woodfields. The clear winner was tench, and I am pleased to say that 300 small tincas have been stocked.

As I mentioned at the AGM, last year's membership held up well though the level is still a concern at 181. If we exclude the restocking it was a breakeven year. However to ensure the club's on-going viability we need to continually make decisions about the finances of the club. There is the high cost of keeping the current river venues, which accounts for 70% of our costs. The matter of the permit pricing which has not increased since 2014, and the continual stocking required to keep Woodfields a place people want to fish.

We had made no decision at that time of the AGM but at a recent committee meeting it was finally agreed to increase permit prices, from 1st June, by £3 for adult and £5 for con-

cessions with no increase for juniors. We have also decided to cease with renting the fishing rights for the third field downstream of Roman Bridge. However we have managed, after a seasons break, to regain the first two fields downstream and will continue with the two fields upstream. All other river venues remain on the ticket. With these actions, if membership levels hold we should be able to invest in more fish for Woodfields during 2019.

On the coaching side, the Upper Ouse Angling Club had a very successful 2017. Over 100 youngsters attended a "taster" session with eight juniors further developing their skills by attending the Structured Coaching sessions based on the CAST Award scheme.

Again, there is a full programme of fixtures and events for 2018 (overleaf). The programme includes the usual series of matches, The *Alan Bedward Memorial*, the newly named *Friday Cup* (incorporating the *OAP Series*), The

*Stan Smith Memorial Series* and six matches that make up the Junior programme including the new Bernard Lewis Junior Trophy which will be fished for on the 11 August.

I would like to thank Mark Murfet, who has recently resigned from the committee, for his hard work and hope that he continues to help with the junior coaching sessions. Also I would like to welcome three new members to the committee. Mark Fenning, Richard Burdon and John Hewison, who returns having served previously, a few years ago, as Match Secretary.

I would also like to thank the committee, those that helped at last year's BBQ, and the team that maintains Woodfields for all their hard work.

Finally I thank you for your on-going support of the club and look forward to seeing you at one of the many events we are holding.
