# BUILDING A FUTURE FOR ANGLING

## Background

The Upper Ouse Angling Club was set up by a group of volunteers in 2015 dedicated to the promotion and coaching of fishing and the looking after the water and countryside environment.

Most of our coaching has been with young people and students with varying abilities. In 2016 we had over 100 youngsters attend our taster events and coaching sessions.

## Our Team

Our team consists of eight licensed coaches, six level one coaches and two level two coaches, plus a support team of volunteers.



## Junior Academy

We hope the angling club's junior academy will go from strength to strength to create another generation with a passion for fishing, outdoors and the environment.

We have run a number of coaching sessions with local Scouts, Guides and Cubs groups and, since 2016, we are able to offer attainment of the Angler badge.



## Opportunities to Get Involved

The club invites people and groups to get involved, with a chance to have a go and learn new fishing skills. There are also opportunities to assist the club by volunteering to help with sessions, gain coaching skills and generally support our angling activities.

## Teamwork

The team work closely with the Angling Trust and both Buckingham and Brackley Angling Clubs. These clubs offer their support and the use of their fisheries for our coaching sessions and junior matches.
