CHAIRMAN'S UPDATE

The club has faced a very challenging year with the devastating pollution event that occurred in June affecting 25km of the Great Ouse between Brackley and Thornton. This event may have a long lasting effect on the quality of river fishing on this section and also on the club's membership levels and finances going forward.

However, all is not lost, as we have taken a number of steps to mitigate the impact on the club which includes working with the various interested stakeholders, the EA, Buckingham Town Council and riparian owners to ensure the event does not fall off the radar and to continue to support the recovery and restoration phases.

There is some good news in that the EA has recently stocked 8,000 chub at various points along the affected stretch and more restocking is planned later in the year.

Membership was down 25 from last year though many members had already rejoined before the event so

the full impact on the club's finances may not be felt until this year.

Going forward we would like to thank the riparian owners of the affected stretches who have reduced their rentals which has enabled us to reduce permit prices for 2019-20 season. Adult membership will now cost £35, Concessions £25 and Juniors remaining at £10. Day tickets have been reduced to £5 with all the river venues remaining on the ticket. Lenborough, The Coombs and Roman Bridge were all unaffected by the pollution with Lenborough fishing particularly well.

Further restocking of Woodfields has been put on hold because of the uncertainty on future income. Though we have done some preparatory work on plans to install an otter fence at Woodfields. Initial estimates have been prepared which will enable us to apply for a grant, later in the year, to help fund this investment.

On the coaching side the club had a very successful 2018 with over 50 youngsters attending a "taster" session

with eight juniors further developing their skills by attending the Structured Coaching sessions based on the Angling Trust CAST Award scheme.

Again, there is a full programme of fixtures and events for 2019 (overleaf). The programme includes the *Jamie Ballinger Memorial Trophy* (Saturday 8 June), the *Alan Bedward Memorial Series*, the *Friday Cup Series* (incorporating the OAP trophy) and the *Junior Series*. However because of the low attendance the *Stan Smith Memorial Series* has been shelved though there will be a single open match to fish for this trophy on Saturday 6 July.

I would like to thank the committee, those that helped at last year's BBQ, and the team that maintains Woodfields for all their hard work.

Finally I thank you for your on-going support of the club and look forward to seeing you at one of the many events we are holding.
