CHAIRMAN'S UPDATE

Unfortunately, at the time of going to print, Woodfields lake is closed to members as we adhere to the latest Government advice and guidance regarding Coronavirus. Hopefully it won't be too long before we can go fishing again. Please check our website www.bdaafishing.org.uk for the most up to date information. Our match programme (see overleaf) is subject to change. However the website and noticeboard at Woodfields will be kept up to date. We also had to cancel our AGM in March, however there were no resolutions tabled and I am pleased to report that the audited accounts show a £700 surplus that has been added to the Woodfields Improvement fund more about that later.

Anyway, I hope you have had an enjoyable 2019 fishing our clubs waters. The river fisheries not effected by the pollution event in 2018 have fished particularly well with some excellent chub being caught. We were also cheered and would like to take the opportunity to thank Environment Agency for their work to introduce chub, roach and dace into the effected sections of the river Ouse and we hope these sections will start to produce fish in the future.

I also wish to thank our riparian owners who have allowed the club to keep the fishing rights for sections of river at a reduced cost. However, for the coming season we no longer have the stretch from Moreton Mill downstream to just above Twin

point. All others remain on the ticket.

The free fishing in Buckingham has also improved due to the stocking and well worth fishing however even with this being free and local we do hope that anglers will continue to support our local club and enjoy our river venues as well. Supporting the club will allow us to continue to influence locally and ensure that our interests are understood and enable us to make a difference. I congratulate the local council for their work with the environment along the Buckingham sections.

At Woodfields lake the club has had another successful year coaching young anglers and the junior matches have been well attended. A special thank you to our coaches and volunteers.

Woodfields is being maintained to a wonderful condition and a big thank you to those involved. Due to the mild winter I am expecting weed to be a problem again this coming season, I would encourage all of us to help with weed raking, however if you do remove weed then all I ask is that it is placed in the wooded area behind the path. If we all do a little we can make a huge impact.

New last year was the double peg which takes up the space between pegs 37 and 38. This double peg has been a great success helping with coaching, supported fishing, family fishing and friends fishing. With this success in mind we applied for and was successful with a grant application from Buckingham town council's

community fund, to allow us to build a second double peg (joining pegs 4 & 5). The risk of predation at Woodfields remains high so the committee applied for a grant from the Angling Trust improvement fund to install an otter fence . The application was successful, however we had to withdraw as it only funded just under 50% of the total cost and the club didn't have the funds to make up the difference. We have also delayed any re-stocking until we have secured the venue from Mr Otter.

In order for the club to proceed with the otter fence and other improvements to the venue the committee has decided to charge a levy of £10 on all membership sales for the next two years to address the shortfall. This levy will be ring fenced within the BDAA accounts as the Woodfields Improvement Fund. The fund on 1st Feb stood at £3,700 however we are dependent on being successful with this year's grant application for us to have enough funds to install the fence later in the year.

For this coming season we hope to reach our targets to carry out improvements at our fisheries. We would like to improve the accessibility, control predation and improve stocks. To achieve this we hope you all will continue to support the club in any way you can and we feel that the club will improve for all of us.

We hope our fisheries are the ideal way to spend time carrying out the sport we love during these uncertain times.
