CHAIRMAN'S UPDATE

Dear Member

Thank you for being a member for 2020/21, a year of restrictions but for most of the year we were lucky enough to able to continue fishing. It became obvious to us that fishing meant more to us than we realised. It was an opportunity to escape the house and to engage with nature, to meet friends socially distanced, and helped with our mental wellbeing.

The year saw our membership grow as people were able to take advantage of fishing the club's waters. Members not only enjoyed the fishing but also appreciated the idyllic surroundings of Woodfields. Many excellent carp were caught and many enjoyed the resurgence of the sport on rivers Great Ouse and Claydon Brook.

Last season I decided to return to many of the river sections and swims I fished in my youth. I enjoyed sessions at Leckhampstead, catching small fish with catches over 10 pounds and then in the winter walking miles successfully finding chub on the Claydon Brook. Please have a look at the short videos on our website where I tried to share my experience on the river hoping to encourage members to give the river a try. My key piece of advice is go light and be prepared to walk some distance, trying lots of likely spots and you will likely find the fish. I also encourage all of you to share what you catch by sending us your photos.

The club last year was successful in acquiring grants to improve Woodfields. The Angling Trust helped fund

the otter fence and Buckingham Town Council funded the building of a second double peg. A special thanks to both.

These double pegs are popular with members as they help support family fishing, social fishing with friends, and in the future they will be important for the coaching and "Come and Try" sessions we plan to hold.

Regarding the otter fence, a special thank you goes to James Turner of Embryo and especially Richard Formosa and his team who worked through the worst weather conditions possible to install the fence. A great job done.

Predation on our lake has been top of our agenda. Otters and cormorants have been visiting the lake and with the club's ambition to have a mixed fishery we have taken action to control access for these predators. The otter fence has been now been installed and to reduce the impact of cormorants we have put ropes across the lake to reduce their visits. These will be removed early May.

While we have had grants to help with the work we have also made use of the money contributed by you all to the Woodfields Improvement Fund.

Although the installation was done by a fencing company, the fence has only been made possible by the amazing team of volunteers who helped clearing the fence line and cutting hedges amongst many other tasks. I can't thank you all enough.

With predation precautions in place the club have started to improve the fish stocks. Our ambition is to have a mixed fishery. Unfortunately we did lose a few of the big carp just prior to the fence

being completed. However, we have introduced a new generation of carp which were at about 1lb. We have also introduced 6,500 mixed silvers and 200 skimmers. I hope you will notice the difference. Next year we plan to introduce other varieties of fish such as tench and crucian carp

Along with improvements to the fish stocks the club's aims are to improve access and facilities at the lake.

As a member you can support the club in many ways:-

- By just being a member. Last year we raised contributions above our running costs which helped us fund the improvements
- By making donations, these were significant last year which helped with our finances
- · By helping with coaching
- By helping with maintenance
- By taking part in our events
- By looking after our countryside environment and being the eyes on the bank or even litter picking
- By spreading the word about the clubs fisheries, perhaps bring a friend fishing on a guest ticket
- By letting people know about the benefits fishing brings to people
- By being involved in the club can be so much more then fishing and so rewarding and helping us promote a welcoming atmosphere.

I look forward to seeing you all enjoying fishing in the new season.
