CHAIRMAN'S UPDATE

Dear Member

Sadly, Bryan (aways with a "y") Bedward, long time friend of the club, passed away peacefully on the 21st March 2023. Our thoughts are with his family and friends at this time.

Bryan instigated the Wednesday night trophy in memory of his brother Alan. To commemorate both their lives the trophy will be renamed the Alan and Bryan Bedward Memorial Trophy.

Last year, we sadly lost Bernard and from the donations made we now have a memorial bench in place at the inlet end of the lake.

We have been very busy over the year, and as you may have noticed, we now have a log cabin, the Woodfields Lodge, funded with a generous donation by Pete Callow. So a big thank you to Pete. This was completed earlier in the year and now has a patio area with picnic table. A thank you to all those volunteers who made this possible. This new club facility will be really useful for committee, AGM, and working party meetings and somewhere to meet up at our fishing events.

From the two grants awarded last year, from Buckingham Town Council (BTC) and the EA, we have purchased two accessible platforms, an accessible toilet, a dissolved oxygen meter, and materials to repair many of the fishing pegs.

The first platform, installed on peg 39, can be used by anyone that by using this platform makes fishing possible.

Unfortunately, for the 2023-24 membership year, we have had to take the decision to increase the price of both adult

and concession memberships by £5. This decision was not taken lightly and is the first increase since 1st June 2018.

Going forward, we plan to install a second double "T-shaped" platform in peg 38 and continue repairing the fishing pegs.

For the accessible toilet, the plan is for this to be open from mid-May and through the summer months. This period may be extended beyond the summer if funds allow.

On the river we plan to hold some working parties to tidy-up and clear access on many of the popular fishing spots.

From early May, we also plan to hold working parties on Tuesday's from 5.00pm to cut and clear the weed. Although this year we plan to deploy a water dye that suppresses weed growth. However it may take a couple of years to see if this works for us.

Please let us know if you wish to come along to help with any of river or Woodfields working party sessions.

From a fishing perspective, last year's stocking of tench was a great success with fish up to 2lb being regularly caught. Bream were also stocked last year and in recent weeks the number being caught has significantly increased.

We do have a further stocking of tench and bream on order for delivery in April.

The carp stocked three years ago have now reached the 6lb mark and are showing quite regularly. The carp, from a previous stocking, have reached the mid-teens and higher with one caught last year at around 28lb.

The rivers around Buckingham are still recovering and it is good to hear chub and brown trout up to 2lb being regularly caught.

The Padbury Brook has again been the star of our fishing venues with people catching up to 10 chub (to 4lb) in one session. The most successful method seems to be the roving one, feeding regularly with liquidised bread, and trotting in each swim for about 10 minutes before moving on. Once you have caught one there is usually a few more around.

On the match front, following on from the recent success of the Open match we plan to use the same format and hold these at regular intervals throughout the year. We have also added a carp match to the schedule (see overleaf).

Also our Facebook page has proved popular with over 90 followers. Check us out under *buckingham and district angling association* and also our website for the latest club news.

Finally, a thank you to our committee and all those that helped on the various projects and made this all possible and thank you to all those that have made donations to the club as it all helps us to improve Woodfields. It is very much appreciated.

I look forward to seeing you all enjoying fishing in the new season.
